


Troy School District Student Cards at Troy Public Library

All students within the Troy School District have access to resources at the Troy Public Library. Parents must "opt-in" for students to gain access to digital resources via a Library eCard or visit the library to sign-up for a regular library card to gain full access to resources and services.

Opt-in for a Student Library eCard (Digital Resources Only)

- Go to: https://ps.troy.k12.mi.us and login
 - If you do not have a login for PowerSchool or need assistance logging in, please email pssupport@troy.k12.mi.us and the PS Support team will contact you within one business day
- Select Other forms & Links on the bottom left side
- Select Library eCard Opt-in
- To give permission for you student to receive a Library eCard, put a checkmark next to "I agree"
- Select Submit



It may take up to 10 business days for your student's ecard to be available. Your student will not receive a physical card, but can gain access to digital resources, such as ebooks, digital audiobooks, and databases by using 212739 and their student ID number. If asked for

a pin, use the student ID number.

To gain access to digital ebooks and audiobooks through the library most users will need to download the Libby App (For Overdrive) or Hoopla App from the App Store on their devices. Find out more about Troy Public Library's Digital Resources at troypl.org and select Downloadables or Resources A-Z from the menu at the right of the screen.

Apply for a Full Access Library Card

If students need access to physical materials at the library (books, audiobooks, DVDs, etc.) they may apply for a traditional library card to gain full access to collections and services.

Use the Get a Library Card link to go to the online library card application. Visit the library to receive your library card. A parent will be required to show their driver's license for their children to receive a card.
